Blessed Peter Wright Cluster Listening Report

Summary of Responses

The Listening Methodology

- Listeners were trained by the diocesan team from across the three communities.
- Responses were received from all three communities, the Pastoral Parish Council and the under-18s group.
- Groups used the 'conversation in the Spirit' method, which encourages every voice to be heard.
- A discernment group of clergy and laity are working with the results of the listening to produce the main themes in this report, and then create scenarios towards the final plan.

What we heard:

What is good about our Catholic Community?

- Good sense of community in individual churches
- Warm welcome on arrival
- Loyal, committed communities
- Intergenerational participation with families and young people present especially at St Paul's
- Regular Mass schedule with resident priest
- Opportunities for music and singing at all three churches
- Active Society of St Vincent de Paul (SVP) supporting charitable work
- Extraordinary Ministers from Thrapston and Raunds visiting housebound and sick across the cluster
- Opportunities for Adoration and weekday Masses

Current Needs and Challenges

- Difficulty retaining teenagers after Confirmation
- Need for more youth-focused activities and liturgy
- Financial pressures
- Limited social spaces for gatherings and events
- Large catchment areas creating transport challenges
- Lack of cluster-wide unity parishioners reluctant to attend other churches
- Cultural and language barriers affecting integration
- Raunds community feeling forgotten or marginalized
- Concerns for pressure on single priest serving multiple locations
- Need for more lay involvement and leadership



Ways to Seize New Opportunities

- Consider becoming one unified parish (Blessed Peter Wright)
- Explore building partnerships or closures to reduce financial burden
- Improve church visibility and accessibility
- Restore tabernacle and Blessed Sacrament at Raunds
- Involve local East Timor community members more directly
- Organise cluster-wide events, trips, and social activities
- Establish regular coffee mornings and social gatherings
- Create communication networks (WhatsApp groups)
- Develop car-sharing systems for Mass and events
- Restart children's liturgy programmes
- Involve Oundle School students in liturgical roles and community service
- Create youth groups and activities
- Make churches more family-friendly with space for children
- Strengthen ecumenical relationships with other local churches
- Increase outreach to new housing
- Collaborate on community needs like food banks
- Develop adult faith formation programs
- Survey parishioners about desired involvement opportunities
- Regular fundraising activities (jumble sales, 100-club)
- More lay leadership in various ministries
- Prayer groups across the cluster

- Creating scenarios as a response to these realities
- Holding an open meeting for parishioners to respond
- Creating a finalised plan

What is the feast of the Translation of the Relics of St Thomas Becket (1118-1170 AD)?

The "translation of the relics of Thomas Becket" refers to the formal transfer of his remains from his original tomb in the crypt of Canterbury Cathedral to a new, elaborate shrine in the cathedral's Trinity Chapel.

This event, which occurred in **July 1220** (fifty years after the saint's martyrdom), was a major ceremony attended by King Henry III and other dignitaries. The translation was a significant moment in the veneration of St. Thomas Becket, transforming Canterbury into a major pilgrimage site in Europe. The shrine and its contents were eventually destroyed in **1538** during the reign of King Henry VIII, as part of his break with the Church.
