#### National Walking Pilgrimage – Way of St John (South)

## Our Lady's Statue MHNJ and the Cluster

Those who have been a while in the parish will know that Fr Graham Platt who was once our parish priest brought a blessed statue of Our Lady back from a shrine in France (maybe someone with a good memory will remember which one!) The statue has been used to borrow for a week or so, to take home to cherish, for a specific intention or thanksgiving but possibly just to enjoy a particular devotion to Our Lady. It's a small plain cream coloured statue (not the white one with gold trim) on the shelf in the entrance hall, and there is bubble wrap and felt bags for safe transportation. There will be a sign up sheet so we can keep track of where she has got to and so that you can book ahead if there is a special event or anniversary which you wish to mark in this way. Visitors from Thrapston and Raunds are welcome to take her too.
